Administrative/Biographical History

Joseph Sackowitz was born on April 8, 1911. He was employed at the Brooklyn Navy Yard from 1941 – 1945 and helped build the USS Missouri. He died in 2006.

Scope and Content

This collection contains assorted personal effects belonging to Joseph Sackowitz during his employment at the Yard. Papers are related to the USS Missouri, including photographs and letterhead commemorating its launching. Highlights of the collection include a personal keepsake - a metal heart made in 1943 by Sackowitz for his wife while working on the Missouri - and his first aid handbook, published by the Office of Civilian Defense.
