The USS Austin was laid down in February of 1963 by the New York Naval Shipyard. She was launched on June 27, 1964, commanded by William H. Shaw. She was decommissioned in 2006 at Naval Station Norfolk, Virginia. The anchor and bell from the vessel is permanently preserved by BNYDC and is on display in the Navy Center at BLDG 92, the Yard's visitor center.
