Administrative/Biographical History

Michael and Vincent Faiella ran a military tailor shop in Brooklyn in the 1960s. Michael was born on October 21, 1928, nearly a year after his father, Natale, established the shop Reliable Naval Tailoring. The store was located at 14 Clermont Avenue, across the street from the Brooklyn Navy Yard. In 1971, Michael purchased the building and inventory for Frank's Naval Uniforms, located down the road at 106 Flushing Avenue. He renamed his father's shop Reliable & Frank's, where he and his son, Vincent, oversaw operations. It is believed the shop shuttered for good in 2007.

Scope and Content

This collection contains uniforms and other articles of clothing from Reliable and Frank's. Two full uniforms, a jacket, hats, a patch, and a pin are included in the collection.
